

## AG STRUCTURES CLASS PROJECT

It is the policy of the Sanborn Central School District that the Ag Structures Class may undertake the project of building a residential home for an interested party under the supervision of the class instructor and building consultant. This project will be contingent on student interest.

1. *Project selection:* Notice shall be given through the Board minutes and/or Rebel e-News of the District's willingness to receive requests for a project home. Interested parties shall submit their statement of interest, specifications, and proof of financial responsibility to the Business Manager by the date and time specified by the Board notice. (By noon on June 7, 2012 this year.) The Superintendent, Business Manager, Building Trades Instructor, and Consultant will review all requests and specifications and shall hold a lottery from all qualified statements of interest no later than August 1. (June 11, 2012 is the date set for this year's house.) Criteria for selection for the lottery shall include but is not limited to the proposed specifications and the party's assuming financial responsibility for purchasing all materials and paying for all expenses incurred plus a donation to the District for completing the project. Preference will be given to a patron of the Sanborn Central School District.
2. *Specifications:* The exterior and interior specifications and location of the new home shall be determined by the interested party and submitted with the statement of interest. It must fit on the 30' X 56' jig.
3. *Costs:* (1) As the construction of the residence is in conjunction with the Vocational Agriculture program within the District, the owner shall be responsible for payment of any labor required to be done by other persons. (2) The owner shall also be responsible for purchasing all building materials and supplies, having materials/supplies delivered to the site, and incidental costs incurred by the District. (3) The owner shall authorize, in writing, the District to order such materials and supplies on owner's account(s) as may be necessary to meet the specifications. (4) The bills for all materials and supplies and outside labor shall be sent directly to the owner by the suppliers/laborers.
4. *Completion of project:* Upon completion of the project the owner will give the District a monetary donation.
5. *No requests from interested party:* If, after the deadline subsequent to the notice being given by the Board for requests, no request has been received, or, if the Committee does not recommend approval of any bids for the lottery due to specifications and/or financial responsibility of the applicant, the class will do other projects in 2012-2013.
