Qualifications for student:

1. Senior student of Sanborn Central School District
2. GPA of 2.5 or better
3. Active participant in school activities such as music, sports, or academic clubs
4. Active participant in other activities, such as church groups, civic groups, or volunteer work
5. Short essay (250-300 words) on any facet of patriotism
6. Must be accepted at a post-secondary school
7. Submission of a statement on how the student plans to pay for the schooling and a list of activities both in and out of school.

Terms of Scholarship in 2012:

1. \$1000 payment in two installments, second installment contingent on successful completion of first semester with a 2.0 average and full-time student status (First semester transcripts sent to Commander, Jackson Hall Post 47, Artesian, SD 57314)
2. Paid to a 4-year or 2-year College/University, or Vocational Institute
3. Non-renewable to be used in one school year
4. Decision to be made by the officers of Jackson Hall Post 47 after personal interview with applicants
5. Preference to children and grandchildren of US veterans
6. Scholarship presented at commencement ceremony;
7. Deadline for application **April 13 at 3:00 pm to Mrs. Whitney.**
