

Sanborn Central/Woonsocket

Girls Basketball, Boys Basketball, Volleyball & Track Cooperative Proposal Starting in 2011

(NOTE: This proposal is intended to be equal for each school as much as possible.)

1) NAME OF THE SPORTS COOP (Basketball, Volleyball, Track):

Sanborn Central/Woonsocket SCW Flipped with a coin.

2) MASCOT: Blackhawks will be the official mascot.

3) COLORS: Black & White with Blue & Red trim.

4) SCHOOL SONG:

Each School will keep their school song and school songs will be played at their respectable home games.....Rotate when possible on the road.

5) PARENT'S NIGHT:

Parent's night would be rotated each year. Example- Boys BB in Woonsocket and Girls BB in SC and rotate following year. VB rotates every other year.

6) CONFERENCE:

The coop would participate in the 281 and CBH Conferences and Mid-Dakota Conference for Track

7) ATHLETIC DIRECTOR:

Both Schools would utilize their A.D. for the coop. The A.D.'s will work together for scheduling/etc. Both AD's will be in charge of their own home games (Refs, Organization, etc.)

8) PRACTICES:

Both schools will have 50/50 practices.

9) GAMES:

Both schools will host 50/50 home games. The A.D.'s will work and coordinate the scheduling with home games for the interests of each school. The gate receipts will be taken and kept with the host school. The host school is responsible for the official's pay and mileage and any other expenses.

10) COACHES:

Boys Basketball- Co-Head Coach Troy Olson, Co-Head Coach Rod Weber, Asst. Sam Olson, Asst. David Steele

Track- Head Coach Justin Siemsen, Asst. Rick Olsen, Asst. David Steele, Asst. Shelley Schlicht

11) CHEERLEADERS: (If there is interest)

Each school would allow 4 cheerleaders for a total of 8 cheerleaders. Each school would run their own try-outs, etc. In case one school does not fill the roster of 4 cheerleaders, the other school can fill the rest of the total number of 8. Cheerleading advisors would be 50/50 between each school with all costs.

12) TRANSPORTATION:

Each school would run their own busing to practices/games/etc. AD's would divide bus driving between the two districts for games.

13) TRAINING & ELIGIBILITY RULES:

Training & eligibility rules will apply to what each school currently is doing. Both schools have similar training rules established.

14) UNIFORMS

The Booster Clubs from both schools graciously volunteered to donate money for new uniforms in all sports.

15) OTHER EXPENSES:

All other expenses will be shared evenly between both schools.

Ex.- Awards, Basketballs, Volleyballs, standard equipment. Sanborn Central will be the fiscal agent.
